

MUSGRAVE PARK FAMILY FUN DAY held on the Friday of NAIDOC week each year, delivers family friendly entertainment and activities to showcase aspects of Indigenous Australian culture and heritage across various mediums of performing arts, traditional foods, arts and crafts, to contemporary aspects promoted by Australian Indigenous Entrepreneurs.

This event is the largest of its kind in Australia and brings together Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities from near and far across Brisbane, Queensland and New South Wales.

NAIDOC WEEK is significant celebration for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people that provides a platform for the preservation and promotion of Australia's oldest living culture; to enhance Indigenous Australian's access and participation to services that can enhance their well-being and increased support to our families; and for the provision of cultural awareness for all Australian's, towards the spirit of true reconciliation.

While at this event we will be taking a large mat to use for all children to sit on throughout the day. This will be situated near the stage area for the children to enjoy the program of dancing, singing and other performing arts.

An Educator will be at this mat at all times, giving the children the ability to go and explore different areas, participate in the various art and craft stalls under the supervision of an educator.

I am suggesting for the children to buy their lunch at the event. The children may even try some of the Traditional Foods on offer. Children will also have the option of buying from the stalls. All purchases will be supervised by an educator.

Each child will have a small bag with their name on it to keep their money in and when required the educator can pass this to the child to complete any transactions.
